

MESSAGE FROM IMAM

Noah's Arc to Surviving and Preserving Our Faith

All praise belongs to Allah SWT, and we ask Him to shower His peace and blessings upon His beloved messenger, Muhammad, pbuh, his family, companions, and followers.

In the spirit of Prophet Ibrahim, pbuh, Allah SWT says: "Remember when Ibrahim said, 'Lord, make this town safe! Preserve me and my offspring from idolatry. Lord, the [idols] have lead many people astray! Anyone who follows me is with me, but as for anyone who disobeys me- You are surely forgiving and merciful. Our Lord, I have established some of my offspring in an uncultivated valley, close to Your Sacred House, Lord, so that they may keep up the prayers. Make people's hearts turn to them, and provide them with produce, so that they may be thankful. Our Lord, You know well what we conceal and what we reveal: nothing at all is hidden from Allah, on earth or in heaven. Praise be to Allah, who has granted me Ishmael and Isaac in my old age: my Lord hears all requests! Lord, grant that I and my offspring may keep up the prayer. Our Lord, accept my request(supplication). Our Lord, forgive me, my parents, and the believers on the Day of Reckoning." 14:35-14:41

What can we do to preserve our faith and the faith of our offspring?

In the above beautiful verses from chapter 14 (Ibrahim), we can learn that Prophet Ibrahim, pbuh, was a father who took actions to preserve his faith and the faith of his offspring with prayer and supplications.

He placed his family near the Sacred House of Allah SWT. He prayed and asked Allah SWT to make people's hearts turn to and love these houses of worship. He lead by example and prayed and wanted his children to follow in up keeping their prayers.

He praised Allah SWT and recognized, acknowledged, and attributed all of the bounties and blessings he had to Allah SWT, the Provider of all blessings. He was concerned for and cared for others, and therefore prayed often for his parents, offspring, and all the believers.

- Work on our homes, and make them homes that nurture faith, peace, and God consciousness. An environment for our children to grow, have fun, be secure, comfortable, and always remember Allah SWT in all of our affairs and activities.
- 2. If you can afford to, we must enroll our children in full time Islamic Schools. We are so blessed to have INTAC right here on our campus and in our backyard!
- 3. Enroll our children in our weekend Sunday school, and supplement that with much more, since one day per week for a couple of hours can never be satisfactory for any kind of education, but it is among other complementary and supplementary efforts.
- 4. Enroll our children in all of the youth programs and activities provided by our Masjid.
- 5. Sign up for our ICGC weekly electronic newsletter to be well informed of all of the exciting activities and programs provided and planned for us by our beautiful Masjid.
- 6. Participate, as a family, in all of the social, religious, and educational activities provided by our Masjid.

- 7. Join our annual community Umrah trip, if you can. It is a fantastic opportunity for experiencing an amazing blessed spiritual journey visiting the Holy Ka'abah, Blessed Cities of Makkah and Madinah, The Prophet pbuh, as well as the over ten thousand companions and great scholars resting in the blessed Al-Baqee'.
- 8. Attend national and local Islamic conventions, where many national speakers share enlightening and very beneficial lectures and programs.
- 9. Come visit the Masjid with your family, at least once or twice per week, even if it is just simply to pray and go.
- 10. Make time, to come visit and participate in the extraordinarily uplifting and spiritual Ramadan experience provided to us by our most beautiful ICGC. We must not deprive ourselves and families from these amazing opportunities.
- 11. Come and bring your children, spouse, and friends to partake in any of the multiple volunteering opportunities offered by, and available to you, at your local Masjid.

Please come and follow the legacies of our beloved prophets, Ibrahim and Muhammad (peace be upon them), to make the masjid your spiritual home. Over the past few decades, Muslims who have maintained an attachment to the masjid, have, by the Grace of Allah SWT, maintained their faith, identity as balanced Muslim Americans, and seen that perpetuated in their offspring.



Please join me in contributing to ICGC's success this year through a personally significant donation and by signing up to volunteer on one of our diverse programs and services teams.







EARNED REVENUE % Earned Revenue \$34,329
