For the remainder 2023, there is a plan to open a free clinic in the summer at the center (Shifa Health Clinic run by a sister organization), the children's playground and picnic shelter are also scheduled to open this summer, InshAllah. A major future project includes a multipurpose community center.

As part of a 2030 vision for our center, for the next several years, we plan to further our collaborations with other masajids in the Cincinnati and Dayton areas. We also plan to expand our social services outreach, add additional programs for the youth and seniors, and to create more programs for the young adults within the community. I am grateful for the opportunity to serve ICGC as the Chair of the Board of Trustees. I ask Allah (SWT) to forgive my shortcomings. My wife grew up in this community and I have been here for 33 years. We are blessed to raise our three children here. We have fond memories of Ameen celebrations, basketball tournaments, Weekend school graduation and Nikkah ceremonies all at ICGC. He has blessed us with truly a beautiful center and a wonderful community.

May Allah SWT pardon all of us and our loved ones from the hellfire. May He bless us to worship Him in the best of ways. May He SWT accept from us.

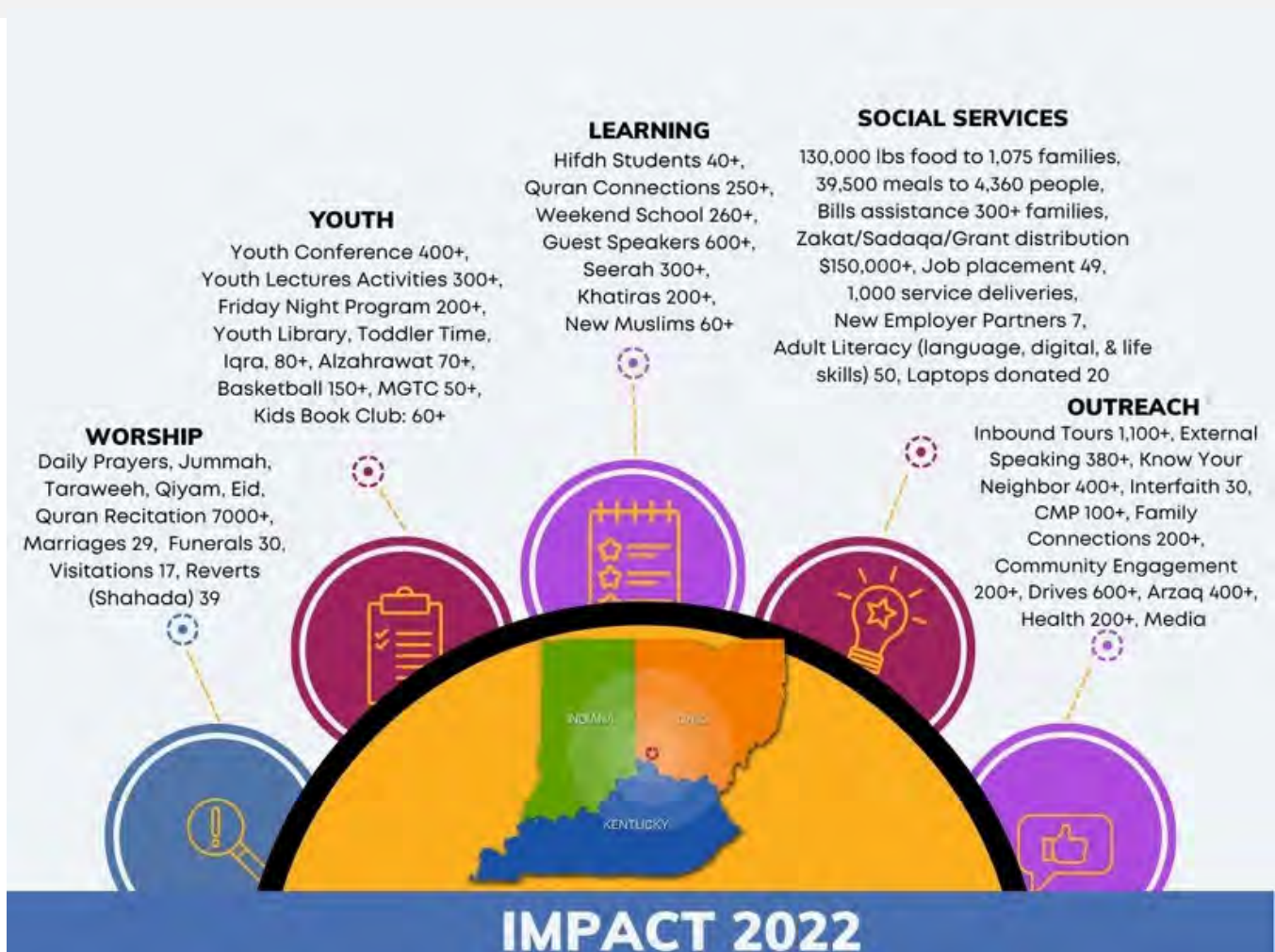

Worship is a key focus area at ICGC. In 2022, we experienced a record surge in our Friday prayers, serving over 2,000 people each week. Our daily prayers average over 100 people. Eid prayers increased from 5,000 to over 7,000 attendees. Over 60 people went on the community Umrah trip.

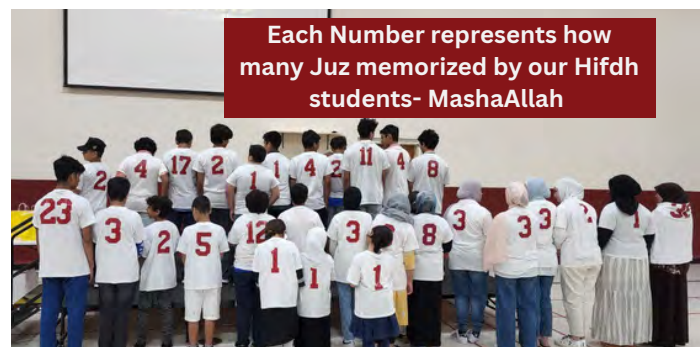

In 2022, ICGC made a giant leap in pursuing our goal to develop the foundation of faith and its deeper understanding in both youth and adults:

- Over **1,200 participants** through various learning programs and activities
- Record attendance for our **Khatiras** with a variety of relevant topics and **Seerah** sessions
- **Quran Hifdh** program had over 37 young Muslims memorize over 90 ajzā' of the Quran.
- **Quran Connections** had over 180 youth learning to read Quran competently and independently.
- Over 260 youth enrolled in **Islamic Weekend School** providing a healthy, loving environment to build a strong Islamic foundation in their lives.
- **"Keys to Jannah"**- a MUHSEN certified special needs class at IWS
- **Annual Day**- Over 67 contestants from 3 different states, over 20 schools, and from over 10 cities competing in Quran recitation
- Over 40 teams participate in the annual **Basketball Tournament**.
- Learning center provided a unique immersive experience with **Renowned Scholars** from Mishkah University and other institutions across the country.
- **New Muslim** team grew in number with ongoing classes and support
- Continuing to engage our members spiritually, socially, and intellectually

Our activities are meant to entertain, accelerate learning, inspire social service, and grow our children into productive members of society. By staying connected to the Masjid, children establish a healthy self-esteem as Muslim Americans who can make many positive contributions to their world. We accomplish this through various and diverse youth programs.

More than 900 youth served in 2022!

- **Friday Night Program** - a multilayered program consisting of youth counselor led groups, Islamic discussions, hands-on learning, workshops, games, and field trips
- **Ramadan Programs** - personal and spiritual growth through overnight youth Qiyams, Fajr challenges, community Suhoors & Iftars, and service projects.
- **Youth Board**- develop leadership skills
- **Summer Camps** with activities and Islamic learning.
- **Muslim Girls Teen Club (MGTC)** for young female teenagers with Islamic values and activities such as painting, board games, parties, cake wars, and more
- **Alzahrawat** program for younger girls to learn Islam in a fun environment along with crafts, field trips, workshops, overnight camps, and volunteer service projects
- **Younger children** were served through youth library, book clubs, story time, art /writing competitions, and cultural programs.

YOUTH

"I grew up in a small town in Northern New Jersey where there aren't many Muslims. There was a lot of post-9/11 discrimination. So, I didn't feel safe living there as a Muslim. ICGC has helped him learn more about Islam and become a better Muslim. I have "100%" made lots of friends at this mosque." (Pakistani, Male, 17)



"Fitting into the outside community is a challenge sometimes. People are exclusive, and because I am different people don't try to include me sometimes. But I feel welcome and comfortable at ICGC since I grew up at ICGC. The Youth Program helps me to bond more. I have gotten closer to a friend that I meet at ICGC events who goes to the same school that I didn't know before. At the ICGC youth programs, I like talking about the outside world and the difficulties about it, like peer pressure, and the toxicity in the Muslim community."

"I live near Clifton mosque and only come to ICGC for youth events on Fridays. The youth events are very well organized, the counselors are really nice and I like that they are younger. I enjoyed the youth conference, the bonfire, and the barbecue."

Essential Needs

We address a family's immediate needs in order to stabilize their situation. Our food pantry provides access to nutritious food, dairy, fresh produce, and personal hygiene items.

- 130,000 lbs. of food distributed
- 39,500 meals
- 1,075 families served (85% increase)
- 4360 people served (91% increase)

Emergency Needs

Our goal is to provide a safe space for families to engage, heal and grow.

- 200+ households helped via Bills Asst. program.
- \$150k+ distributed through Zakah, Sadaqah, and grants to pay rent & utility to ensure families stay in their homes.

Employment

We help individuals create an action plan around employment, education, career development, and skills building. Program commitment ranges from 1 to 3 yrs.

- 49 Job Placements (28% Increase)
- 1000+ total service deliveries (75% Inc.)
- 7 New Employer Partners

Adult Literacy

We offer In-person and online classes that are interactive and hands-on with a focus on ESL, Digital Literacy & Citizenship for adult learners interested in becoming engaged citizens.

Success Stories

Ibtisam came with a 6th grade education. Further, when she arrived, she didn't know English. She spoke Arabic only. She started from the beginning i.e. from ABCs and learned speaking, writing and reading. ICGC also helped her with essential & emergency needs, employment support, and connections to entrepreneurship coaching. "Now I have my own business. ICGC has always supported me. I really appreciate their hard work. So I really like to work with ICGC to help people and tell them if you want to do something, you can do it."

Ibtisam now owns Olive Tree Restaurant.

Aml Mohamed completed the Foundations of Digital Literacy course that provides digital literacy foundational skills, including mobile based for those without computers. She also participated in in-person tutoring for conversational English and online tutoring which was connected to various tech-assisted learning methods. All of this unlocked and updated a lot of latent language skills and gave her a lot of confidence. She is now enrolled in a formal program for studying cyber security, scheduled to start after Ramadan.

Client 3

L is a single mom who returned to the US in October 2021. After the Lebanon disaster, she lost everything and decided to return to the USA. She is now trying to settle here. We helped her to pay the rent for a few months and referred to our employment coach to get a job and stand on her feet.



Client 4

As a new refugee coming to this country, R felt his work options were limited. He tried to find a job in his field but it was difficult. We were able to get him a job while we searched for a better position that would be related to his field. After months of searching, we were able to get him a position with one of our partners that gave him a higher level position. He had a \$7/hr increase in income which significantly impacted his family's financial stability. He is working on improving his language so that he can continue to grow into higher positions.

MAJOR FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS



In 2022, we did a complete gym floor renovation from concrete to premium professional wood and repainting of the walls. With this renovation, we were able to redirect the youth, especially college age youth and young professionals, who play basketball from going to offsite facilities for sports, to reconnect them with the center/masjid.

We also renovated the Mirror Hall to give a fresher look but also to help with our space needs with additional uses.

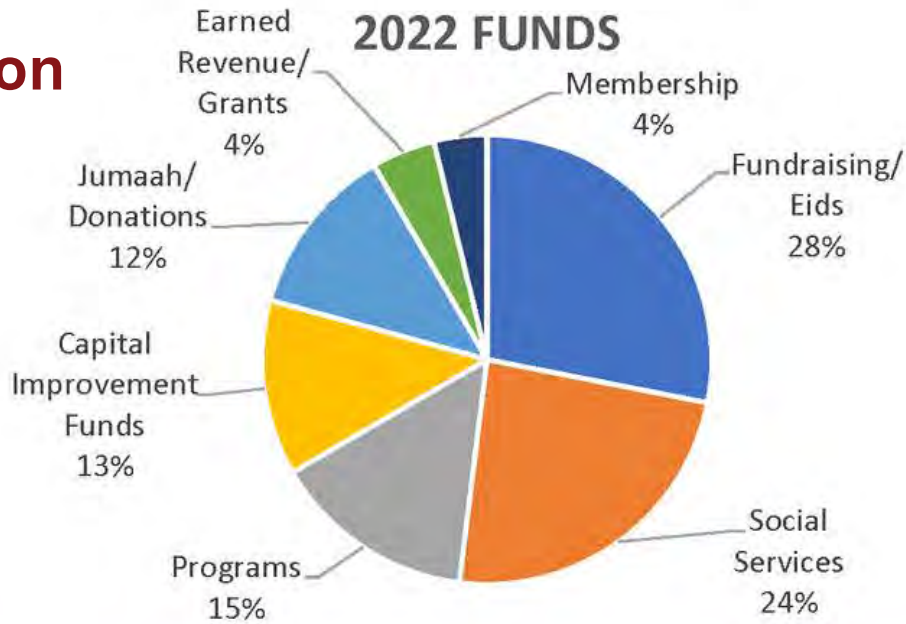
The parking lot was resurfaced to address the wear and tear from more than two decades of use.

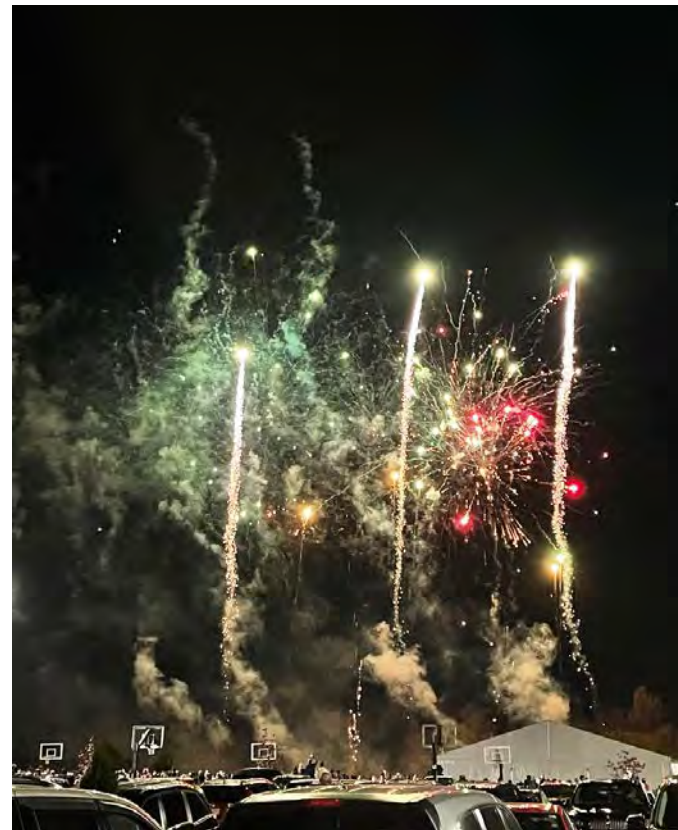
